Academic Counseling

When you enroll, a personal academic counselor will be assigned to your family. Your counselor will answer your questions about Homeschool Plus, and assist you in making decisions that affect your child's education—from beginning placement to graduation with a CLE diploma. All our counselors are committed to caring and professional customer relations.

Your counselor will contact you periodically. In addition, you may call your counselor toll-free at any time during normal business hours. Help is also available by mail, fax, or e-mail.

Parent Training

You will receive a free training packet when you enroll. These LightUnits deal with CLE curriculum structure, Biblical principles of education, and procedures for a successful homeschool. You may take the course by correspondence or during a summer session at a CLE Training Center. A CLE Homeschool Teacher's Certificate will be issued upon successful completion of the training.

Included in your training materials is *The Homeschool Handbook*, a valuable tool that—

- answers many questions you will face as a new homeschool family.
- outlines the responsibilities and privileges of homeschooling.
- offers tips and suggestions for organization.
- is filled with encouragement and resources.
- helps you benefit from the wisdom and experiences of others.

Achievement Testing

CLE Homeschool Plus families may purchase achievement tests for students enrolled in our program. The California Achievement Test (CAT) provides national norms for evaluating student progress in comparison to other students of the same age, and for diagnosing areas of academic weakness so remedial steps can be planned. (The cost of the achievement tests is not included as part of the CLE Homeschool Plus fees.)

Achievement tests also help determine the recommended starting place for your student in CLE Bible, science, social studies, and reading. Your counselor can help you interpret and apply the results.

Record Keeping

We maintain a permanent record based on Quarterly Progress Report forms you send us for each enrolled student. From this file we can assist you with feedback, verify the progress of your homeschool to authorities if needed, and send official transcripts to other schools and colleges. Your student's file includes—

- transcripts of a student's work from previous schools, if available.
- a record of academic work and attendance while in our program.
- a profile of the student's standardized (achievement) test results.

You record time, attendance, and work completed on the provided Quarterly Progress Report forms. Four times a year you send these reports to us and we enter the scores into the student's permanent record.

We send a computerized cumulative report each quarter, plus provide report cards for you to fill out for your students.

Academic Projections

If you have a high school student, you will fill out an academic projection. The projection divides the schoolwork into the number of years the student expects to spend in high school. This provides workable goals and encourages long-range planning. Your academic counselor will be happy to assist you with this.

Diplomas

The CLE high school diploma provides a tangible and recognized verification that the student has successfully completed a prescribed program of studies. It also testifies of perseverance and diligence. There are three diploma programs, each with different levels of requirements.

CLE provides the opportunity for seniors and early graduates to prove their achievement by passing the CLE Diploma Qualifying Test. Acceptable alternatives to this test include the SAT, ACT, or GED tests. Test scores determine if the student qualifies for the diploma they are pursuing. This adds credibility to the student's diploma when dealing with other authorities.

Transcripts

Transcripts are provided upon written request for all students, whether currently or formerly enrolled. Transcripts are the official record of high school credits earned, showing the student's grade point average for work completed while enrolled in our program.

One of the valued services we provide is sending your student's official transcripts to schools and other organizations upon request.
